

## School Rules

There are not many School Rules at Brookfield House School.

They are there to make the school a safer and more enjoyable place to work.

It is important that pupils follow the 'School Rules' and the 'Code of Conduct' at all times.

Pupils should:

1. Speak politely to everyone.
2. Follow instructions given by a member of staff.
3. Move quietly, carefully and sensibly around the school.
4. Arrive at all lessons on time.
5. Stay in the classroom unless the teacher gives permission for you to leave.
6. Remove outdoor clothes, including hats, when in the classroom.
7. Put all litter in the rubbish bins.
8. Remove jewellery during PE and practical lessons such as Technology and Science.
9. Only eat and drink at break and lunchtime only - chewing gum is banned in school.
10. Only use personal stereos, radios, mobile phones etc. on the way to and from school - not on the school premises.
